RACE TRACK



RACE REGULATIONS

Art. 1 - The race is only open to active members of Rotary International or Rotaract who are member of the Fellowship Cycling to Serve. They may not have, however, a licence as a professional of any organisation affiliated to the UCI (Union cycliste international). Each participant is riding on his own risk. (Medical/Sanitarian Safety).

Art. 2 - The races are subdivided according to age-categories:

1° Category: over 65 years	born before 01/01/53
2° Category: from 55 to 65 years	born between 01/01/53 and 31/12/62 and woman without any age limit
3° Category: from 45 to 55 years	born before 01/01/63 and 31/12/72
4° Category: under 45 years	born after 01/01/73

Art. 3 - The race will be under the control of the race director, appointed by the Rotary Club Montegranaro to assure safety and regularity. The race director's decision is final.

Art. 4 - The competitors must present themselves at the check-in at least one hour before the start of the race, with their identity papers and Rotary membership card.

Art. 5 - The competitors should have an acceptable racing bike and wear appropriate cycle clothing.

Art. 6 - A certified cycling Safety helmet is obligatory.

Art. 7 - Identifications/Numbers/Transponders must be attached at the directive of the race organizers.

Art. 8 - The races start with a mass start in each category. Competitors are racing as individuals. Helping fellow competitors is prohibited.

Art. 9 - Lapped competitors may be asked to leave the race, if considered necessary by the race-director.

Art. 10 - Participation Fee of € 50,00 per competitor is to be paid before the race.

Art. 11 - At least 80% of the entry fee surplus will be distributed as prizes between the Charity Funds of the Clubs whose members have finished in the first five of their race. The total amount available for prizes will be equally distributed over the five official racing categories. Per category, the portions will be as follows:

1° : 30% 2° : 25% 3° : 30% 4° : 15% 5 : 10%

The amounts will be deposited to the charity fund of the RC by transfer to the RC Account after the World Championship weekend.

Art. 12 - Clubs and supporters are free to donate prizes.

Art. 13 - The event insurance covers only the statutory obligation with reference to public liability.
